FASHION PHOTOGRAPHY

This course brings together the **key concepts of photography and fashion** to provide students with a 360 degrees training in fashion photography. By teaching **technical photography skills** but also offering an **insight into the fashion industry**, this course gives students a comprehensive understanding of fashion and the **role a fashion photographer has within this industry**. In order to provide students with an “insider” point of view, they will **study and work with professional fashion photographers, make-up artists and stylists, and model agencies**.

COURSE DATES: MONDAY JUNE 30, 2025 – SATURDAY JULY 5, 2025

SCHEDULE: from Monday to Saturday.

From Monday to Friday classes will be both in the morning and in the afternoon; on Saturday you will have a morning activity only.

» Classes: **9:30-12:30 and 14:00-17:00**

TOTAL AMOUNT OF HOURS: 33h.

Language of instruction: English

LOCATION: Istituto Italiano di Fotografia, via Enrico Caviglia 3, Milan (Italy)

TOPICS:

- » Understanding the key concepts and styles of Fashion Photography
- » How to use light and exposure in fashion photography, including studio and natural light
- » Shooting techniques for fashion photography and organising a fashion shoot
- » Studio and on-location fashion shoots
- » Fashion styles and trends
- » Hairstyles and make up in Fashion
- » Fashion collections: structure, timing, themes
- » Brand charter: what it is and why it's important for the photographer
- » Materials and fabrics
- » Model casting for a fashion shoot
- » Postproduction in Fashion photography
- » Meeting/working with professional fashion photographers and stylists

NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS: The minimum number of participants is 5. The maximum number is 12. We'll confirm the course activation to enrolled students by June 10, 2024. This way, you will have the time to organise your travel. If the course isn't activated, course fees will be refunded in full.

PREREQUISITES:

- » Good photographic skills and knowing how to shoot manually (es. knowing about aperture, time, exposure)
- » Knowing the principles and function of photographic composition
- » Knowing how to manage files (raw and jpg)
- » Knowing how to use Adobe Photoshop

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:

- » A digital camera with manual mode, a memory card and batteries compatible with your camera
- » A battery charger (and an adapter to European socket, if your charger doesn't have an Italian plug)
- » Optional: a USB flash drive or hard drive to facilitate file transfer

CERTIFICATE: Certificate of attendance.

PRICE: 800€ (taxes included)

HOW TO ENROLL:

- » Fill in the online Enrollment form
- » Pay the 800€ course fee by June 4, 2025
- » Send the receipt of your payment to study@iifmilano.com (and a copy of your passport/ID if you need a visa)

HOW TO PAY:

Methods of payment: cash, check or bank transfer (instructions for the payment will be received via email upon filling in the enrollment form).

Payment options:

- » Option 1: a single 800€ payment when applying (by June 4, 2025)
- » Option 2: pay the 200€ enrollment fee when applying; pay the 600€ balance by June 5, 2025

WITHDRAWAL:

Students can withdraw from the course at any time. Enrollment fees are not refundable. The refunded amount depends on when the student will withdraw. If you withdraw from the course, you will receive:

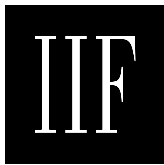
- » a full refund (the enrollment fee is not included), if you withdraw by May 1, 2025
- » a 50% refund (the enrollment fee is not included), if you withdraw by May 15, 2025
- » no refund, if you withdraw after May 15, 2025

PROFESSOR SARA EL BESHBI CHI:

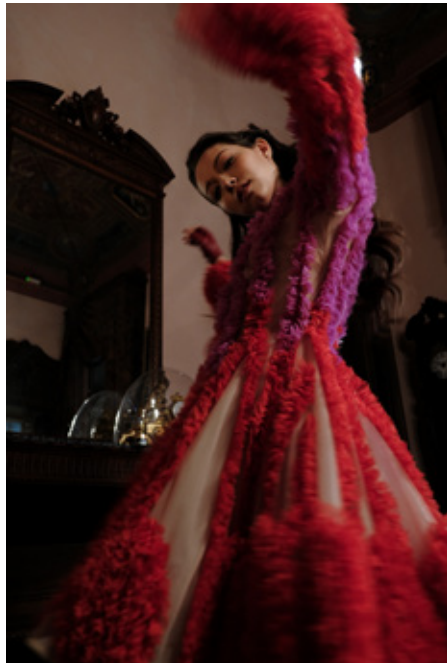
